1 Kenai Peninsula And Seward *(Sail at 8 p.m.)*

Depart Anchorage and head south on the Seward Highway along Turnagain Arm where the luxury Celebrity Summit awaits. Spend the next seven days sailing through Alaska's Inside Passage waters.

Dinner On Board

2 Hubbard Glacier *(Afternoon Cruising)*

Today's voyage takes guests to the massive ice wall of Hubbard Glacier. Hubbard is the second most active tidewater glacier in Alaska. Watch glacial ice cascade down into the ice choked waters below.

3 Juneau *9 a.m. - 9 p.m.*

Dock in Alaska's Capital City, Juneau. Optional shore excursions are available to purchase at this port including the Mount Roberts tram, experience Mendenhall Glacier by helicopter, or whale watching excursions.

4 Skagway *7 a.m. - 8:30 p.m.*

Welcome to the "Gateway City to the Klondike Gold Rush"! This historic community still has the feel of an 1898 boom town. Enjoy touring this unforgettable town. Shore excursions are available for purchase including the Skagway Street Car, White Pass and Yukon Route Railway and Dog Sledding by helicopter.

5 Icy Strait Point *6:30 a.m. - 3 p.m.*

Just 22 miles southeast of Glacier Bay National Park, Icy Strait Point is the only native owned and operated wilderness port in Alaska. It has been the homeland of the Hoonah Tlingit natives for thousands of years. Optional shore excursions are available for purchase including the mountaintop gondola, North America's largest ZipRider and ATV adventures.

6 Ketchikan *9 a.m. - 6 p.m.*

Known as the "Salmon Capital of the World", this vibrant community offers a number of adventures for its visitors. Optional shore excursions are available in this port including the Bering Sea Crab Fisherman's Trip, visiting Totem Parks and fishing.

7 Cruising *(At Sea)*

Hug the coastlines of Alaska and British Columbia taking in the scenery offered by the Inside Passage. Keep an eye open for marine wildlife during your day at sea.

8 Vancouver, British Columbia *(Dock at 7 a.m.)*

Dock at Canada Place Pier this morning. Disembark and pass through Canadian customs before being transferred to the Vancouver or Seattle airport.
