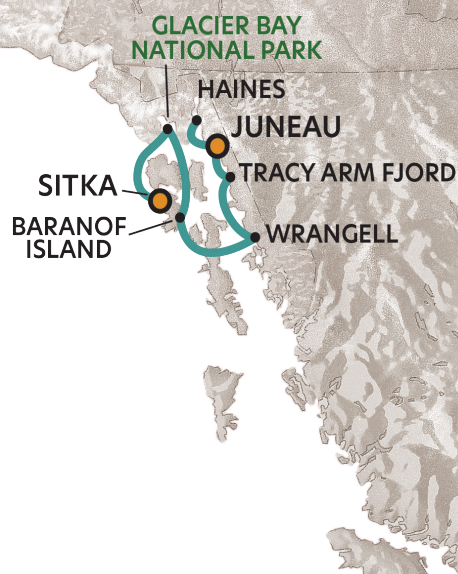

1 Juneau

Welcome to Juneau - Alaska's capital city. A John Hall's Alaska representative greets guests at the airport for a transfer to the accommodation for the evening. Rest well, an exciting week lies ahead!

2 Juneau

Following a guest welcome breakfast, it's time for guests to experience Juneau. Visit Glacier Gardens before enjoying lunch and free time. This afternoon, arrive at the Admiralty Dream and experience the private dining experience of Orca Point Lodge.

Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner

3 Glacier Bay National Park

Arrive early at one of America's crown jewel national parks and a UNESCO World Heritage Site and Biosphere Reserve - Glacier Bay! Deep in the park view tidewater glaciers, icebergs, and waterfalls. Keep watch high and low for bears, whales, moose, eagles, and mountain goats.

Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner

4 Haines

Experience one of Southeast Alaska's hidden gems and most scenic communities, Haines. Spend the morning visiting the Tlingit heritage of Haines, experiencing the Jilkaat Kwaan Heritage Center and village of Klukwan. Enjoy time traveling through one of the greatest densities of bald eagles in the world before a free afternoon to explore the town of Haines at your leisure.

5 Exploration Day

First charted in 1794, the waters of the Alexander Archipelago are frequent playgrounds of humpbacks and orcas, and the area's many nooks and coves make it great for visitors of all kinds - perhaps a chance to kayak, hike, or ride in the skiff. Have the camera ready, eyes on the horizon, and see what the day brings!

ARRANGING YOUR FLIGHTS

LAND TOUR + ADMIRALTY DREAM: Flights may depart Sitka after 12pm on the last day.

6 Tracy Arm Fjord

At Tracy Arm Fjord - the heart of the Tracy Arm-Fords Terror Wilderness and home to twin Sawyer Glaciers - cruise the length of this glacially-carved, jade-green fjord, tracing granite cliffs rising 4,000 feet above sea level. Surrounded by waterfalls, hop in the skiff for an up-close exploration of South Sawyer Glacier (conditions permitting). Keep watch for marine life, harbor seals, Arctic tern, and mountain goats.

Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner

7 Wrangell

Visit quiet Wrangell, an area inhabited by the Tlingit people for thousands of years and the only town in Alaska to have been ruled by four nations - the Tlingit, Russia, England, and the United States. Explore the town's colorful history at the Wrangell Museum. This afternoon, get set for adventure with a jet boat tour on the Stikine River, the fastest navigable free-flowing river in North America.

Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner

8 Eastern Baranof Island

Spend the morning cruising and whale watching before reaching the eastern shores of Baranof Island. Archaeological evidence has revealed people were living here 10,000 years ago although today, the wilderness rules. Join on board naturalists on a guided shore walk, and possible skiff rides and kayaks for further exploration in one of the island's pristine bays.

Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner

9 Sitka

After breakfast, bid a final farewell to the Admiralty Dream crew before disembarking in Sitka. Visits to the Fortress of the Bear - an educational rescue center for orphaned bears, and the famous Alaska Raptor Center - a healing and rehabilitation center for injured avian patients, highlight the community's unique relationship with nature. Guests with afternoon flights have access to the hospitality room in town until the scheduled departure home.

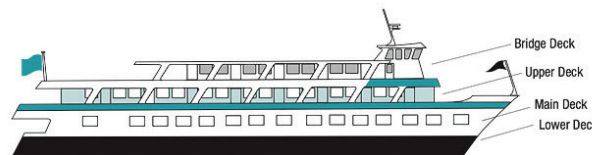

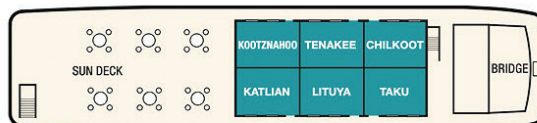

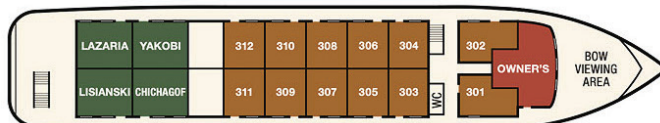

BRIDGE DECK



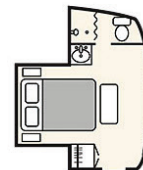
UPPER DECK



MAIN DECK

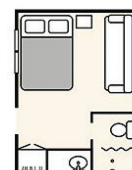

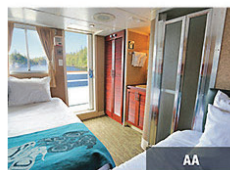

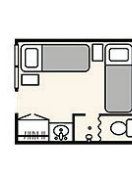


AAA: Two twin beds (Lisianski queen only), large picture window, wardrobe, private bathroom with shower. Approx. 122 sq. ft.
