2 Glenn Highway & Valdez

4 Wrangell-St. Elias NP & Fairbanks

Visit Trail Breaker Kennel - home of the late four-time Iditarod champion Susan Butcher - for an exclusive look at kennel life and a dog mushing demonstration. Stop at the Fountainhead Antique Auto Museum before a savory salmon bake and Alaska style entertainment at the Palace Theatre.

6 Alaska Railroad & Denali National Park

Board the glass-domed railcars of the Alaska Railroad and experience luxury GoldStar service with breakfast served on board during the journey to Denali National Park. Upon arrival, board the Kantishna bound bus for the 6-hour, 92-mile scenic journey into the heart of Denali National Park and to the Denali Backcountry Lodge, the remote and quiet lodge for the next two evenings. Not only is this journey into Kantishna a limited opportunity, it also gives visitors a greater chance of seeing Mount Denali in full glory, getting visitors as close to the mountain as possible.

Settle in for the evening at the Hotel Captain Cook and enjoy a farewell dinner with traveling companions.
